2023-2024 Estimated Cost of Attendance and Financial Aid

School of Pharmacy – Palliative Care (MS)

Applicants needing federal and institutional financial assistance to help with the cost of attending a school or program at UMB must complete the **Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA)**. Please note:

- USFA strongly encourages completing the FAFSA at <https://fafsa.ed.gov> no later than March 1st for priority consideration
- The 2023-2024 FAFSA covers the 2023-2024 Academic Year (Summer 2023, Fall 2023 and Spring 2024)
- Students must complete a FAFSA for every academic year they wish to receive assistance.

Estimated Cost of Attendance

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is the maximum amount of financial assistance available to a student in one academic year. The COA is determined using each student's enrollment and residency classification (Resident or Non-Resident).
